

- Registration fee includes: attendance to all scientific sessions, welcome reception, coffee breaks and lunches, opening and closing ceremony, exhibition as well as other events organized during the conference.
- The student rates are available only to full time student enrolled in a recognized higher education course at university. Non-compliant delegates will be charged the applicable full registration fee. If you register as a student, please attend the conference with your student ID card.
- The accompanying person rate is intended for spouses or other relatives of participants registered in any of the other categories. Accompanying person registered in this category may not present paper or posters.

Conference Dinner:

We will organize a conference dinner on December 8, which will charge for 60 USD per person. Please pay it together with your registration fee, if you would like attend.

Cancellation Policy:

If notice of cancellation of registration is received on or before September 30, 2018, a refund of fees paid less a cancellation charge of 50 USD will be paid. No refunds are available for cancellations notified after September 30, 2018.

Grant

A fund has been established to provide financial assistance for some international delegates who unable to obtain full support for attendance and will be given to applicants who take an active part in the conference.
