

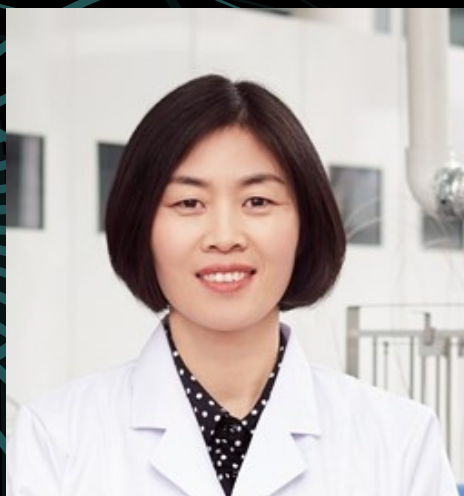

To be considered for the BPA:

(1) A candidate should participate in the workshop and submit a **Full Paper** (no less than 5000 words) to the workshop.

(2) A candidate should be a graduate student, or a young scholar with a PhD degree **less than 5 years**.

(3) Submitted papers should not have been previously published.

(4) Candidates who intend to apply for the EPA, please clearly indicate on the front page of the full paper that **"Submit for EPA"**.

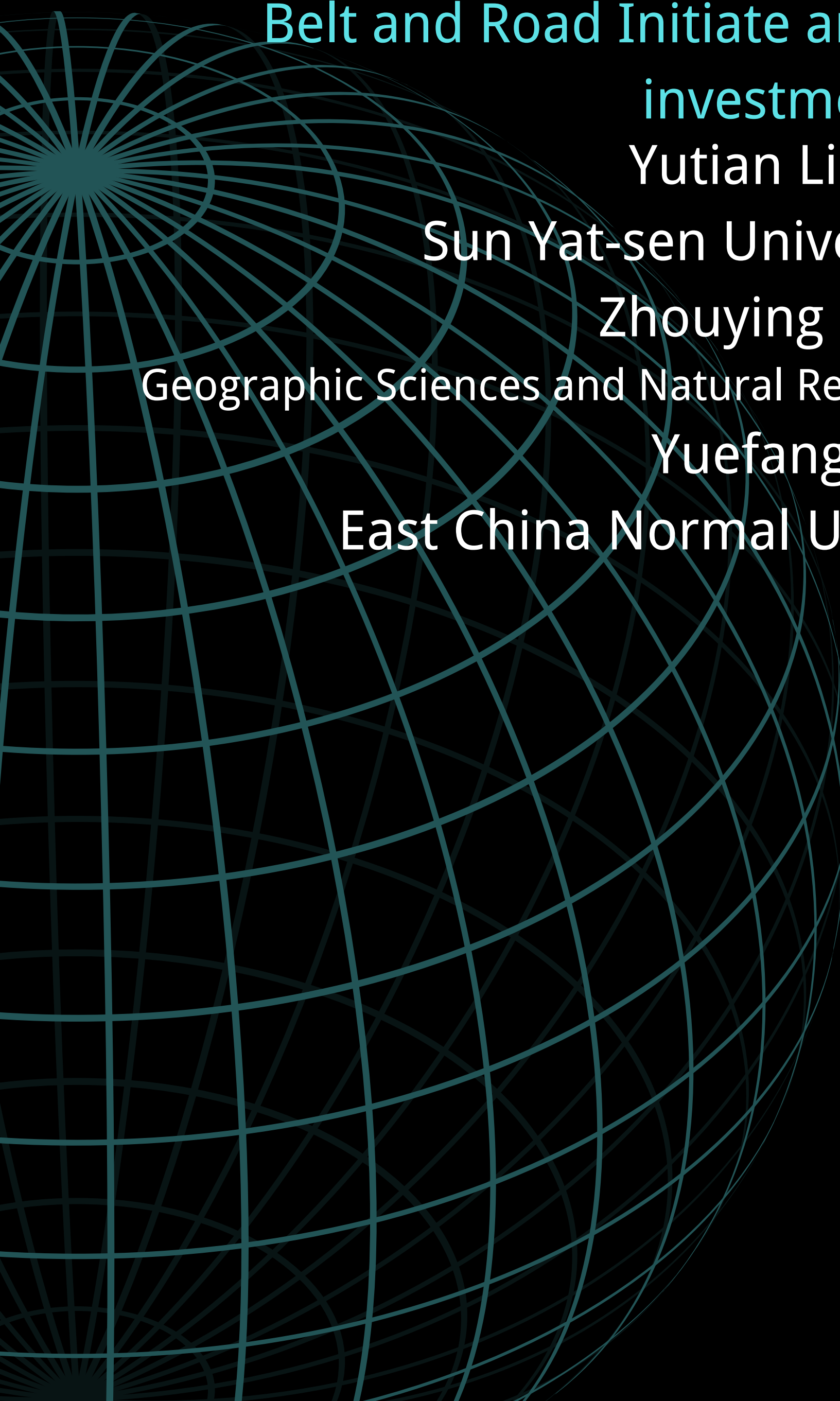
