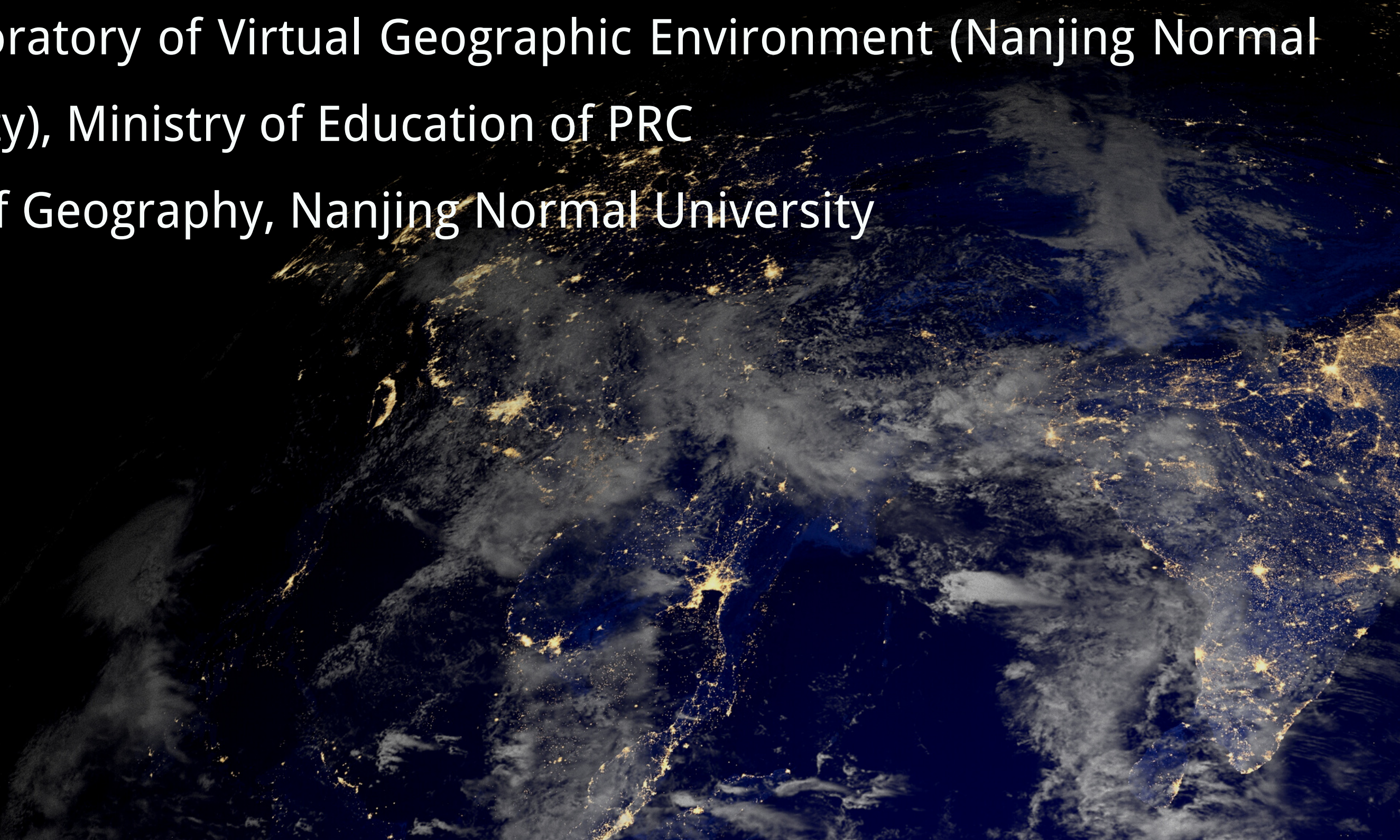



Excellent Paper Award (EPA 2022)

1. To apply for the Excellent Paper Award (EPA 2022), authors must submit a full length research PAPER (5000-8000 words). The paper being submitted for EPA evaluation must not have been published.
2. The award will be granted to several nominated papers selected by the EPA Committee.
3. Applicants must select “Submit for EPA” option when submit their papers using the online submission system.
4. EPA applicants must orally present their papers in the workshop.
5. The deadline of EPA application is Dec 4th, 2022.
6. The winners of EPA will be announced in the closing ceremony.
