# Excellent Paper Award (EPA 2022)

- 1.To apply for the Excellent Paper Award (EPA 2022), authors must submit a full length research PAPER (5000-8000 words). The paper being submitted for EPA evaluation must not have been published.
- 2. The award will be granted to several nominated papers selected by the EPA Committee.
- 3. Applicants must select "Submit for EPA" option when submit their papers using the online submission system.
- 4. EPA applicants must orally present their papers in the workshop.
- 5. The deadline of EPA application is Dec 4th, 2022.
- 6. The winners of EPA will be announced in the closing ceremony.
